Dear Beloved Parishioners of Holy Cross,

This weekend, we celebrate the great feast of Christ the King. We proclaim that Jesus is our King of kings and Lord of lords, and we joyfully commit to following His commandments.

During the difficult times of the pandemic and lockdown, our parish did not sit idle. We reached out in many ways, both spiritually and socially. Through our Diamond Club and parish teams, we regularly supported nearly 200 elderly people and their families. Over 50 Welcome Ministers helped people worship in a safe and worthy manner. Personally, in addition to offering Masses and sending daily recorded messages and prayers, I visited those infected with COVID-19, cooked and delivered chicken curry and rice for them, and boldly entered high-risk hospital wards to bring the final rites to those who were isolated.



Why did we do all these good works? Because when we acknowledge Jesus as our King, we must live by His rules. His greatest commandment is to love God and love our neighbours and to take up our cross and follow Him. This means showing kindness, forgiving others, and helping those in need. We allow Jesus to reign in our lives when we act with the same love and mercy He shows us. Let us ask Him to help us make His love the center of our lives, so we may help build His kingdom of peace and love here on earth.



Your Family's Invitation to Christmas Preparation

Next weekend we begin the holy season of Advent, our spiritual preparation for Christmas. This year, we invite our children to participate in a special way during the Christmas Masses by dressing as angels and characters from the Nativity scene.

We also invite every family to help us decorate our church for Christmas! We will distribute materials for making Christmas wreaths after all Masses this weekend. The Return of Receiving from the Chalice: With the great worries of the pandemic now behind us, we are joyfully able to reintroduce the beautiful practice of receiving Holy Communion under both kinds - the precious Body and the precious Blood of our Lord. As we enter the Season of Advent, a time of preparation and renewal, we will begin this on a trial basis. Starting this weekend, the Precious Blood will be offered to the congregation exclusively at the Saturday 6:30 PM Vigil Mass. This trial period will help us prepare to potentially extend this practice to other Masses in the future. Let us approach this renewal with deep reverence and gratitude, praying that it strengthens our love for the Holy Eucharist.

Christmas Decorations

Please note that receiving the Sacred Host alone is a complete and valid reception of the Eucharist. The entire Christ - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - is fully present under each species. Therefore, no grace necessary for salvation is missed if one receives only the Host.

Christmas Fayre – Sunday, 7th December 2025: Mark your calendars! Our Parish Christmas Fayre will be held on Sunday, 7th December, following both the 9:00 am and 11:30 am Masses. This year, all proceeds will go towards our urgent project to replace the church boilers.
